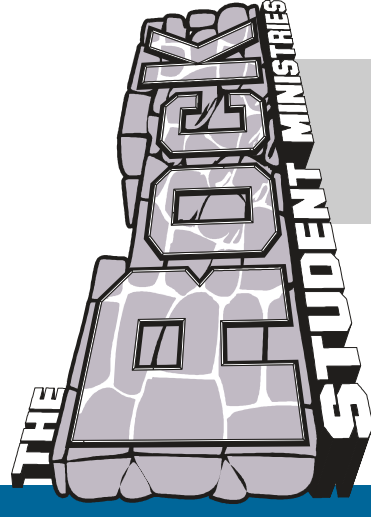


What do I do Next

If you are interested and feel God calling you to serve on either The Student Ministry Team or The Student Ministry Support Team please complete the following steps.

1. Submit a written application to become a member of the Student Ministry Team and a RHBC Leadership Survey (if one is already not on file) to the Youth Pastor/Director.
2. Have a scheduled interview with the Youth Pastor/Director and possibly up to two other current members of the Student Ministry Team.
3. Requests are considered and approved or denied by the Youth Pastor/Director Office as openings occur.
4. If approved for Student Ministry Team there will be a 3 month internship before final approval. At that time you will be asked for a three year commitment to the team.



Explanation of Leadership

Minimum Standard to serve on the Student Ministry Team and the Student Ministry Support Team:

- Be a Christian and a member of Rolling Hills Baptist Church
- Understand and relate well with ALL students in the student ministry
- Understand the concept behind The Rock Student Ministry and goals stated in there for each student.
- Lead by example in conduct, dress and attitude.
- Abstain from all use of Alcohol and Tobacco products.

- ❖ Ongoing Spiritual Growth activities: Daily Quiet time. Prayer and Bible Reading

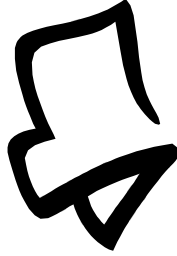


Student Lead Ministry
